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#### COVID

A huge thank you to families for your support in adhering to the many COVID regulations. All going well we expect another delivery of Rapid Antigen Tests to arrive by the end of the week and will notify families for collection.

Families are reminded not to enter classrooms at any time unless given explicit permission. It is also vital that the school be informed of any children with positive COVID cases.

The next two weeks supply of Rapid Antigen Tests are now available for pickup at the office.

#### **School Fees**

School fee notices have been sent out today. You will receive an envelope with your 2022 school fees notice, Direct Debit form and a CSEF form. Camps and excursions will be added to the fees notices at a later date, if the camps go ahead.

Direct Debit will commence on 4<sup>th</sup> March and will continue the first Friday of each month until December. If you wish to have the fees taken out monthly from your account, please complete the form and return to school asap.

Parents with a Health Care Card (HCC), will need to complete the CSEF form and return to school with a copy of your HHC.

If payment presents a problem, please make an appointment to see me to discuss payment options.

#### Car Parking and Safety

Due to safety reasons, cars are not permitted to double park in front of the school, nor are they permitted to park within a certain distance of the school crossing. Whilst parking is of a premium around the school at the beginning and end of the day, I ask that families adhere to the time limits on the signage at the front of the school to allow a smooth flow and maximum access to all.
