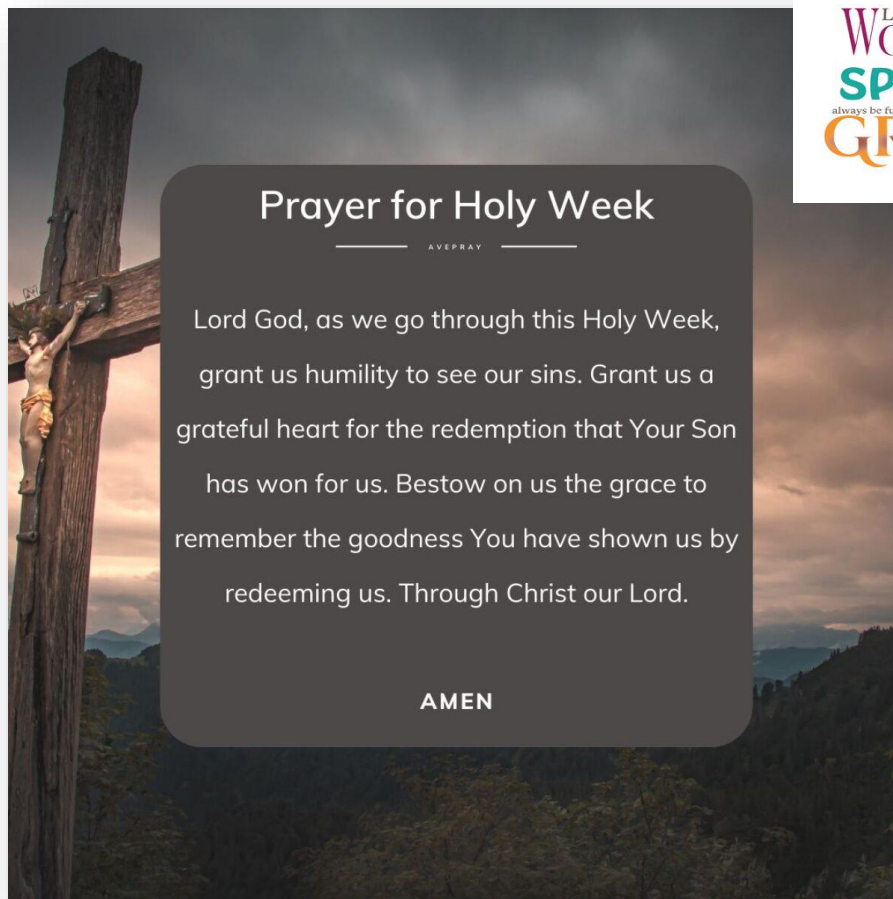

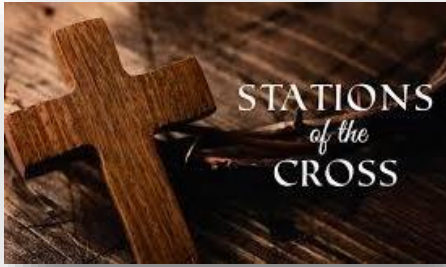
Thank you
