

## **Bikes/Scooter Safety**



Road Safety authorities recommend that children under the age of 9 are supervised by an adult when riding in public. For some, depending on their skills and experience, this age may be higher. Children under the age of 12 may ride on footpaths, as can the supervising adult.

The distance to be covered and the path to be taken should be taken into account by parents/carers before a child undertakes this activity. Parents must ensure students wear approved safety equipment and that bicycles/scooters are in roadworthy condition. Students who have been found to have arrived at school without a helmet will not be permitted to ride home. Parents will be contacted to collect the child.
